The reading of the minutes of our last meeting on June 8, 2022 were waived. The two updates were that John Bither helped with the auction, not Bob Shanks, and Steve W provided a show and tell item, not Steve S. The minutes were accepted as updated.

In attendance: 32 members and 1 guest.

Treasurer's Report: \$17,018 in coffers, including checking and cash. Reduction due to most of the bills now paid for the Spring show.

Old Business

SVCC will be purchasing table cloths for the coin shows. Stats show that we can purchase and re-use for the cost of 1 show rental. It will be a huge cost savings measure.

Soiled cloths will be laundered, but it is expected that most tablecloths can be used multiple times before that is necessary. Color will probably be basic black.

Tickets for the giveaway are available at \$75 for a full book and \$40 for a half book.

New Business:

From our club's last coin show, a dealer survey indicated an interest in having our coin shows open to the public on Sundays, rather than starting on Fridays. A "hybrid" show schedule, where we set up EARLY Friday AM (instead of Thursday PM), and have our

coin show hours modified to be open at 1:00 pm - 6:00 pm on Friday, 10 am - 5:00 pm on Saturday and 10:00 am to 4:00 pm on Sunday. There will be some additional costs to SVCC for this, due to room costs and additional security, but we may be able to defer costs with additional contributions from members and dealers. Members were surveyed about supporting this this change, and it was a mix of opinions.

An anonymous survey will be presented soon by Patrick.

Patrick created a new opportunity for education for SVCC members by playing "Coin Jeopardy" a game played identically to Jeopardy on TV, except all questions were related to Numismatics. At the end of the game only teams with a positive point balance could complete in Final Jeopardy. It was great fun and a lot of information flowed, increasing the knowledge of SVCC members. The winning team was the "Double Eagles."
