EDUCATIONAL PROGRAM: Coin Grading Presented by John Bither

- Dr. William Herbert Sheldon established the current 1-70 point grading system.
- The 4 most important factors affecting grade are strike, luster, bag marks and eye appeal. John stressed that eye

appeal is key.

- It is important to have consistent magnification and reliable consistent light source, incandescent preferred.
- And use a photo grade companion with pictures included. PCGS Photograde is preferred and strongly recommended by John.
