**Treasurer's Report:** Due to recent bourse funds coming in we have \$21,436 in the coffers.

SVCC shirts have been mostly distributed and the last ones were distributed tonight. There are 2 left (XL and XXL) for people who did not sign up for shirts. Also, a second order can be issued but we must have a minimum of 12 shirts ordered to do it. Please see Rick Y. to sign up for a second order.

US Proof American Silver Eagles with the S mint mark were available from the mint, 200K total, and was sold out. But some are still available in case of cancellations.

Coin Show update, Bob S. - of 55 total tables, we have sold 33, with a verbal commitment for another 13 leaving only 9 tables left to sell. KUDOS to Bob for always handling the show so efficiently for SVCC.

Two sign-up lists were circulated: one for volunteers and one for exhibits at the show. We still need a few more volunteers and have at least three slots left for exhibits.

**Show and Tell:**

- Bruce W., who likes ancient Roman and Greek coins, shared a Constantine coin from circa 305 A.D. depicting a cross in the sky, because of Constantine's affinity toward Christianity.
- Mike G. Shared a great many images of "coins on stamps" from a great many different countries. Mike also referenced the stamp show at the Sacramento Convention Center which will be on August 25-28, 2022.
- Pat C. shared a French Indochina coin with the image of seated liberty on their coinage. Reviewing his 20<sup>th</sup> century world coin book, Pat found no less than 16 countries with seated liberty on them.
- Troy D. shared a rare Canadian \$200 gold coin with the image of Wayne Gretzky. Only 1500 were minted.
- Alex B. shared a 1936 Waking Liberty Half Dollar with a DDO.
