Minutes from meeting of August 10 were presented electronically to the club and the reading was waved. Minutes were approved as presented to the membership.

Pat referenced local coin shows including the Fall Sacramento Valley Coin Club Show on September 23 and 24. Pat presented the results of the survey the club did asking members about their preferences as to the schedule for future coin shows. Pat explained, as a result of the survey and discussions by the club's executive board, the club's 2023 coin shows will be 3-day shows. These two shows will have the 3-day format on a trial basis. After the Fall show the club will discuss the merits of the change in show schedule

and decide how to proceed for 2024. The 2023 Spring coin show will happen Friday, April 28 – Sunday, April 30.

Treasurer's Report: Over \$26,000 in the checking account and \$800 in cash for a total of \$27,438.

Sign-ups for volunteers at the SVCC Fall show has been circulated. Please volunteer as you can. Two or more shifts are welcomed. 19 of 22 slots have been filled.

A sign-up sheet for coin show exhibits at the coin show was also circulated. Seven of the eight possible exhibit slots were taken.

Great Coin Giveaway: we are nearing a traditional level of books sold for a “sell out” of 80 books. About 15 books remain. You may purchase from Treasurer Marty H, or at A & D Coin and Jewelry. If sold out, additional books will be added as well as more gold coin prizes.

September 14th meeting will include the drawing for a 1/10th ounce gold coin for those who have bought complete give away ticket books (100 or more tickets at a time).
