Coin Show Exhibit Rules

1. Each exhibitor must be a Sacramento Valley Coin Club (S.V.C.C.) member in good standing.
2. Exhibitor must complete the Exhibitor Agreement prior to being assigned a coin case at the show for their exhibit.
3. Exhibit cases will accommodate an exhibit that is 21 inches by 33 inches. The exhibit cases are “half height” and so exhibits should not have a vertical dimension greater than one inch.
4. Exhibits are typically limited to one coin case. An exhibitor may be allowed to use two cases, if space and availability of coin cases permit. No exhibit may use more than two cases. Request to use two cases shall be made a minimum of two weeks before the start of the coin show.
5. Exhibits shall be educational in nature and shall consist of numismatic material: coins, paper currency, tokens, medals, and related items. No advertising, commercialism or political expression is allowed.
6. Exhibitors shall be provided a lockable exhibit case and key. Exhibitors shall return the exhibit case and key to S.V.C.C. coin show staff at the conclusion of the coin show.
7. Exhibits should be in place and ready for viewing by 10:30 a.m. on the first day of the coin show, except for exhibits by youth members of the club. Exhibits by youth members should be in place and ready for viewing by the public by 10:30 a.m. on the second day of the show.
8. There will be no formal judging of the exhibits. There will be an opportunity for coin show visitors to vote for a “people’s choice” award by casting one vote for their favorite exhibit. The exhibit garnering the most “people’s choice” votes will be awarded a special prize. No person attending the coin show can vote for their favorite exhibit more than once.
9. Exhibitors will receive a gift from the club to thank them for their efforts. The winner of the “people’s choice” award, described above, does not receive the thank you gift from the club – each exhibitor receives one item, either the “people’s choice” award or the thank you gift.
