Inauguration Luncheon

A 2/3 majority voted to approve at the September 28 meeting to increase from \$10 to \$15 per year for regular membership, from \$100 to \$150 for life members, and from \$5 to \$7.50. These fee increases begin January 1, 2023. The motion was approved with more than the required simple majority approving.
